Use a leather point needle in either case and heavy-duty thread. That needle should be between 14 and 18 gauge thick. How to Sew Suede By Hand Or Machine (9 Sewing Suede Tips)

Use a 14 gauge needle for thin to medium weight leathers, and 16 to 18 for heavier skins. Seams can be pressed out as you sew; use a pressing cloth and the

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lowest heat possible on thinner leathers. To flatten a seam in a heavier skin, open the fabric and place heavy, flat weight (books or boards are good) on the seam.

Press seams open with steam from the wrong side. The steam is the key! It made the suede more pliable and after it cooled it held it shape better. I used a low heat and was able to press a bit from the right side on seams where necessary, like around the sleeve cap.

Cut vertical lace slots, five inches apart, all around the four sides. Make the lace slots an inch long and a little less than an inch from the edges. Thread the parachute cord and lace the hide with it; one lace per slot. Tie the laces to the nails on the frame for stretching.

To attach the interfacing to the suede/leather piece, apply glue ~ I like to use a fabric glue stick~ to the perimeter of the suede/ leather piece and attach the interfacing. Baste around the outer edge of the piece with a basting stitch 1/4" from the edge. 6. Use clipsto hold the seams together.

Stitching leather with a Teflon foot. For sewing piping on my leather purse I couldn't use the straight-stitch foot and had to change it for a zipper foot but it had to be Teflon also so it can go smoothly on leather.. Also, a walking foot can be a real lifesaver when sewing leather. I use a Janome 6600 sewing machine and it comes with AcuFeed system which is practically a built-in walking foot.

Every seam on the leather got three rounds of stitches. First, the seam construction, then a row of topstitching along each side to help the seam allowances lay flat. This is where that leather tape came in really handy.

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
